3rd International Teaching Course on Gastrointestinal Endoscopy

Athens, January 23 – 24, 2015

With the presence of the Deputy Head Mission of the Embassy of Japan in Hellas, Mr. Takero Mori, was completed the 3rd International Teaching Course on Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, which was held at the Experimental-Research Center of ELPEN and organized in cooperation with the Endoscopic Section of the Hellenic Society of Gastroenterology (HSG) and the Hellenic Society of Gastrointestinal Oncology (HSGO). The 44 trainees from Greece, Cyprus and other European countries (Germany, Spain and Czech Republic), who participated in this Course of high scientific interest, had the honor to be presented with their Continuing Medical Education (CME) accreditation certificate of attendance by the honorable, Mr. Mori. The teaching Course took place on the 23rd and 24th of January 2015, under the auspices of European Society of Digestive Oncology (ESDO) and the European Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ESGE).

The participants attended **2.5-hour lectures**, followed by a **6-hour hands-on practice** in **modern endoscopic techniques** taught, amongst others, by **internationally acclaimed Gastroenterologists, Prof. Hiroshi Kashida** (Kinki University, School of Medicine, Osaka, Japan), **Yoriaki Komeda**, (MD, Kinki University, Department of Gastroenterology, Osaka, Japan), **Takataro Fukuhara** (MD, Department of Molecular Genetics, Institute for Biomedical Science, Division of Gastroenterology and Hepatology (3rd Department of Internal Medicine, Kansai Medical University) and **Arjun Koch** (MD, Erasmus University, Medical Center, Rotterdam, The Netherlands.)

The presented **endoscopic techniques**, in which all 44 participants were trained, constitute the most **Advanced Knowledge** in the field of **Gastroenterology** and include Endoscopic Mucosal Resection (EMR), Endoscopic Submucosal Dissection (ESD), Clipping-Stenting Techniques, and Endoscopic Polypectomy, Peroral Endoscopic Myotomy (POEM).

The Scientific-Organizing Committee of the International Course noted, "The internationally acclaimed scientists from Japan and the Netherlands, the state-of-the-art research Center and the specialized scientific staff of ELPEN rendered this Course an actual model of medical training. We have every intention of repeating the Course in the future, aiming at offering even more Gastroenterologists the opportunity to become familiar with and be informed about the latest developments in Gastrointestinal Endoscopy."
