2nd International Teaching Course on Gastrointestinal Endoscopy

The Experimental-Research Center of ELPEN in cooperation with the Endoscopic Section of the Hellenic Society of Gastroenterology and the Hellenic Society of Gastrointestinal Oncology contribute to continuing medical education

The completion of the 2nd International Teaching Course on Gastrointestinal Endoscopy, held at the Experimental-Research Center of ELPEN and organized in cooperation with the Endoscopic Section of the Hellenic Society of Gastroenterology (HSG) and the Hellenic Society of Gastrointestinal Oncology (HSGO), was marked with the presence of the Japanese Ambassador to Greece, Mr. Masuo Nishibayashi. The 44 trainees from Greece, Cyprus and other European countries (Germany), who participated in this Course of high scientific interest, had the honor to be presented with their Continuing Medical Education (CME) accreditation certificate of attendance by the honorable ambassador, Mr. Nishibayashi. The teaching Course took place on the 24th and 25th of January 2014, under the auspices of European Society of Digestive Oncology (ESDO) and the European Society of Gastrointestinal Endoscopy (ESGE).

The participants attended **2.5-hour lectures**, followed by a **6-hour hands-on practice** in **modern endoscopic techniques** taught, amongst others, by two **internationally acclaimed Gastroenterologists** from Osaka, Japan: Mr. **Takataro Fukuhara**, MD, Department of Molecular Genetics, Institute for Biomedical Science, Division of Gastroenterology and Hepatology (3rd Department of Internal Medicine, Kansai Medical University) and Mr. **Yoriaki Komeda**, MD, MSc, Wakakusa Daiichi Hospital, Department of Gastroenterology (Endoscopic Center). Gastroenterologists **Mr. G. Alexandrakis**, **Mr. J. Vlachogiannakos**, **Mr. K. Delis**, **Mr. P. Kasapidis**, **Mr. S. Bassioukas**, **Mr. D. Xinopoulos**, **Mr. M. Panos**, **Ms. K. Michelakos** participated in the Course as Instructors, Speakers and Coordinators.

The presented **endoscopic techniques**, in which all **44 participants** were trained, constitute the most **Advanced Knowledge** in the field of **Gastroenterology** and include Endoscopic Mucosal Resection

(EMR), Endoscopic Submucosal Dissection (ESD), Clipping-Stenting Techniques, and Endoscopic Polypectomy, Endoscopic Retrograde Cholangiopancreatogram (ERCP).

The **Scientific–Organizing Committee** of the **International Course** noted, "The internationally acclaimed scientists from Japan, the **state-of-the-art research Center** and the **specialized scientific staff** of **ELPEN** rendered this Course an actual **model of training**. We have every intention of repeating the Course in the future, aiming at offering even more Gastroenterologists the opportunity to become familiar with and be informed about the latest developments in Gastrointestinal Endoscopy."
