The Oncological Referral Center (CRO), IRCCS, of Aviano, Italy is a Scientific Institute for research, hospitalization and health care, highly specialized cancer center of national importance.

CRO Aviano is dedicated to the development of excellence in the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of cancer and rehabilitation of patients after cancer care, through multidisciplinary and integrated patient care, preclinical and translational research, graduate education, and patient empowerment programs.

The clinical activity focuses on medical treatment of the most frequent solid tumors, including rare neoplasias, and haematological neoplasias, oncological gastroenterology, oncological surgery, conformal, intra-operative, stereotactic radiotherapy and IMRT. Clinical research is based on mono- and multidisciplinary therapeutic protocols.

Additional comments:

The Oncological Gastroenterology Division is engaged in assistance and research activities pertaining to preventive, diagnostic and therapeutic functions for primitive and secondary neoplasms of the gastrointestinal tract. Diagnostic endoscopies of the superior digestive tract, diagnostic endoscopies of the inferior digestive tract, ultrasound endoscopies, therapeutic procedures, gastroenterological consultations and functional tests, are performed for inpatients and outpatients. Particular attention is devoted to echo-endoscopic staging with FNAB of digestive cancer, enteroscopy with pillcam and device-assisted, endomicroscopy with pCLE, EMR and ESD, percutaneous endoscopic gastrostomy for decompression and nutritional purposes, protesis, and APC treatments.
